NOTIFICATION

No. No.1-61/Estt/DAH/RR/2019- In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, read with the GOI,Ministry of Home Affairs, New Delhi, Notification No.14/3/60-ANL dated 11th April,1960 and in partial modification of the Notification No.1/2010/F.No.1-61/Estt/DAH/RR/2009 dated 31.12.2009 and Notification No.99 of 2016 dated 19.07.2016, the Hon'ble Lt. Governor (Administrator), Andaman and Nicobar Islands, hereby proposes to make the following rules for regulating the method of recruitment of Group 'C'(Non-Gazetted/Non-Ministerial) post of Laboratory Technician and Laboratory Assistant borne in the Establishment of Directorate of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services , Andaman and Nicobar Administration.

The objections and suggestions are invited upon the proposed Rules from the persons to be effected thereby.The objection and suggestions (if any) should reach the undersigned within a period of 1(one) month from the date of publication of this Notification.

1. Short Title and Commencement: -

- i) These rules may be called the Andaman and Nicobar Administration (Laboratory Assistant and Laboratory Technician in the Department of Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Services) Recruitment Rules,2020.
ii) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Number of Posts, Classification and Scale of Pay: -

The number of posts, its classification and scale of pay attached thereto, shall be as specified in paras 2 to 4 of the Schedules I to II annexed hereto.

3. Method of Recruitment, Age limit, Qualifications: -

The method of Recruitment, Age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the post shall be specified in paras 5 to 13 of the said schedules.

4. Disqualification :-

No person-

- a. Who has entered into a contracted marriage with a person, having a spouse living, or
b. Who having a spouse living has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person;

Shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for doing so, exempt any person from the provision of these Rules,

5. Power to Relax: -

Where the Lieutenant Governor, Andaman and Nicobar Islands is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient to do so,he may by order and for reason to be recorded in writing,relax any of the provisions of these Rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. Saving: -

Nothing in these Rules shall effect the reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and other categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF LABORATORY TECHNICIAN OF DAH&VS

1. To maintain Laboratory equipment's, chemicals in Lab.
2. To be responsible for effective functioning of laboratory.
3. Responsible for coordinating all the work of Lab Assistant & Lab Attendant.
4. Responsible for specimen, Viscera sample packaging for sending to referral Lab in India.
5. To maintain ledgers and placing of indents of Lab equipment's, instruments, reagents and chemicals etc. pertaining to Lab.
6. Responsible for upkeep of all the relevant records pertaining to the lab equipment's, instruments, chemicals etc.
7. Any other work assigned in public interest by the officer in charge.


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Annexure to Schedule-I

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF LABORATORY ASSISTANT OF DAH&VS.

1. Routine dung & Faecal sample examination.
2. Routine Blood sample examination. i.e. blood counts & Blood parasites examination.
3. Clinical Mastitis examination.
4. Skin Scraping Examination of Livestock's & pets.
5. Rumen fluid examination.
6. Routine urine examination of livestock's and pets
7. Blood collection during FMD, during outbreaks such as canine distemper, Avian Influenza etc. from field & serum separations, dispatching of samples to mainland referral laboratories.
8. Collection of swabs (throat, nose, ear, eye & ulcers from fields as well as from Govt. Poultry farm, cattle farm etc.
9. Viscera sample collection from Livestock's & pets and dispatching the same for further investigations.
10. Responsible for the upkeep of all the relevant records pertaining to the Lab equipment's, instruments, chemicals and placing of indent etc.
11. Preparing of MPR, NADRS report and annual report of concerned laboratory
12. Care of Laboratory equipment's & Chemicals.
13. Any other duties assigned by the respective in charge in public interest from time to time.
